

**MINUTES OF

The Council of The Rural Municipality of Alonsa held their Regular Council Meeting on **June 22, 2022**, in the Municipal Council Chambers at 10:00 AM, with Reeve Tom Anderson presiding and with Councillors Colin Mailman, Ed Waczko, Eldon Campbell, Mike Brown, Logan Dumanske and Terry Dayholos present. Also present was Chief Administrative Officer Tami Dumanske as Recording Secretary.

Council discussed the letter received from the RM of Ste. Rose. Council agreed to a 50% cost-share for the maintenance of Road 144N from Road 81W to Road 84W for the grading and snow-ploughing. A resolution will be made when we are invoiced to pay the amount requested.

Advised that we start following The Animal Liability Act. CAO Dumanske is to get in touch with Carli Owens at Prairie Legal regarding a new Herd By-Law.

**Cllr. Brown:**

- Reported that some of trees and bushes need to be removed from the corner of Railway Avenue and Hwy 50 and that a letter should be sent to Manitoba Infrastructure. CAO Dumanske informed that that letter should be sent by the LUD of Alonsa;
- Bluff Creek Road – where creek crosses. Would like to make a permanent damn there;
- Inquired about when we are going to start fixing roads.

**Cllr. Mailman:**

- Reported that F. Lebel's road needs product – he spoke to C. Taylor, Colin going to look at the road;
- Roads in need of repair – Chelle Rd, Tamarack Rd, Rorketon East Rd, Asham Point Rd, Taylor Rd.

**Cllr. Waczko:**

- Reported that two pipes on Glenhope Road were plugged by farmer and they need to be replaced;
- J.Batyski has requested an extension for a culvert.

**Cllr. Campbell:**

- Reported that an additional culvert is needed through the road at the Kinosota Hall and to install a culvert in M.Geras' home approach;
- Inquired when the culvert was going to be replaced at D.Mancheese's.

**Reeve Anderson:**

- Reported that a culvert needs to be installed at R.Anderson's;
- Tom met with Ste. Rose RCMP and reported that they are starting night shifts to help reduce the crime in the area. They would like invites to community events.
- CAO Dumanske is to send a letter requesting that they maybe work with the RCMP on the east side of the Narrows to take turns patrolling the developments on both sides.
