MONTHLY PAYMENT PLAN FOR TAXES

If you find that you are not able trailer. to pay the balance that you owe all at once, we will work with you to set up a monthly payment plan. Please call the office, we cannot help you if you don't get in touch with us.

NOTICE:

We will most likely have two having one for a few years.

ADDRESS CHANGES

If your address has changed you need to notify the Municipal Office BEFORE the property tax bills are printed in June/July. Tax bills are printed by the province, so we cannot make *Monday* changes after they come to us.

BUILDING PERMITS

The Building Permit Application Process is available on our 1st Saturday 10:00-12:00 website along with our Building Permit Application. If you do of every month not have access to our website please get in touch with our office and we will gladly give you everything you need and answer any questions you may have.

CULVERTS

In most situations you will need to have an approved Water 2nd & 4th Rights License before we can sell you a culvert. If you have Saturday of every month concerns or questions please call the Municipal Office.

WATER RIGHTS LICENSES (WRL)

If you've been advised to apply for a WRL by this municipality or *Monday* a provincial department, we can assist you if you need help. Please call the Municipal Office.

GRASS CUTTING

If you own property in one of our towns or cottage developments, it is your responsibility to keep the grass cut. If the RM has to cut it for you, the rate is now \$75.00 per lot. If Tuesday you do not pay the invoices that are sent to you, they will be Thursday added to your taxes.

UNSIGHTLY PROPERTIES REMINDER

By-Law No. 1437 BEING A BY-LAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF ALONSA TO MAINTAIN PROPERTY AND TO REGULATE NUISANCES, DERELICT, ABANDONED AND UNSIGHTLY PROPERTY.

> Please keep the grass cut on your property. Keep your 1st & 3rd property free of derelict vehicles. Do not let garbage pile up on Saturday of every month your property. Even if you have a trailer for your garbage, think of your neighbours and the odours that may come from that

ANIMAL CONTROL

Animals are not permitted to roam free/run at large in this municipality.

SNOW PLOWING YOUR LANE

If you are plowing your own lane/driveway, this is a reminder to southwest of the Narrows ask you to NOT push the snow across the road to the opposite ditch and leave it on the side of the road.
